Position Summary:

Representing Tally's Dockside & CG Hooks BBQ, you will lead small groups of children grade levels 1 - 8 on recreational fishing outing activities. Our fishing guides should have a high interest in fishing and can specialize in their own area of interest while fishing and boat driving.

The camps will last 2 hours with the possibility of two camps per day. The camps are held in the mornings Monday - Thursday with a make-up day if needed on Fridays. They are scheduled in June and July.

Position Duties / Essential Job Functions:

- 1. Maintains familiarity with White Bear Lake and knows the habits of the wildlife in that area.
- 2. Prepare boat prior to departure; load fishing poles, tackle box, bait, towels, first aid kit, ice in a cooler, cell phone, etc
- 3. Drives and maneuvers the pontoon/deluxe fishing boat in and around White Bear Lake and locates good fishing locations.
- 4. Helps campers with their gear, baiting, and removal of fish as needed.
- 5. Responsible for the safety of the group.
- 6. Controls the behavior of the campers.
- 7. All conversation with campers are age appropriate and pertains to fishing, boating, Tallys, and White Bear Lake.
- 8. Requires knowledge of how to administer first aid and is prepared to handle emergencies. Be knowledgable of the steps of first aid.
- 9. Follows good conservation practices and fishing and boating rules and regulations.
- 10. After camp is completed, cleans the boat, fill the gas tank, repairs damaged fishing equipment, and puts tackle and gear away. Advises management of additional items needed.

Qualifications:

- Current American Red Cross First Aid and CPR card preferred.
- Current State of Minnesota fishing license
- Guiding experience preferred with a sound working knowledge of fishing, fishing terminal tackle, angling methods, techniques and skills
- Experience working with or teaching children preferred
- Proficiency with fishing and latest angling techniques and proven familiarity with White Bear Lake and its surroundings

- Demonstrated passion for the work and ability to be reliable, prepared, and dependable at all times
